## **Ardleigh Green Bridge replacement: planned overnight closures of the A127 Southend Arterial Road**

Following the successful demolition of the eastern side of Ardleigh Green Bridge over the Early May Bank Holiday weekend, we now need to move the eastern side of the new bridge structure into position. This will take place during an overnight closure of the A127 on 23 July.

Before we do this we will be testing the strength and condition of the ground along the A127. To do this we need to close the road for two nights in July. Details of all three overnight closures are in the table below.

### **A127 Southend Arterial Road temporary overnight changes**

<b>Dates and times</b>	<b>Traffic impacts</b>
17 and 18 July from 21:00 each night until 05:00 the following morning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- There will be no access for through traffic along the A127 in both directions, between Gallows Corner and the junction of Ardleigh Green Road / Squirrels Heath Road</li></ul>
23 July from 22:00 until 05:00 the following morning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times</li><li>- Access to / from Bryant Avenue will continue to be possible via the A12</li></ul>

## **Buses**

## **Pedestrians**

Access on foot across the A127 and Bryant Avenue will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access to properties will also not be affected.

## **Working hours**

The working hours set out above have been agreed with the London Borough of Havering.

After these closures work will continue in the area on weekdays and on some weekends between 08:00 and 18:00. Much of this work is carried out below street-level, so is not visible. Some work will also take place overnight while there are no trains running.

## **Further planned closures of the A127**

We have more works planned throughout the summer. Some of these works will require further closures of the road in August. We will write to you nearer the time to confirm the precise details of these closures.
